Today we go in search of Puglia's famous trulli houses. These cone shaped dwellings are unique to the region and in the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Alberobello you see a concentration of over 1,000 trulli houses. Our expert guide will bring the history of this picturesque town to life.

Then its off to discover the secrets of cheese-making in the ancient traditions of Puglia. You will meet a local cheese artisan at his farm for a demonstration in the art of making fresh burrata. You may even get to twist a knot of mozzarella or two! You'll see the room where the mozzarella is aged to make the famous scamorza and, of course, sample a selection. A taste of some of the farm's best produce along with some of the freshest cheese you will ever eat!
