This one-in-a-lifetime exclusive wine experience will unfold in the home of Tuscany's legendary red wine, one of the most sought-after wines in the world, the one that is alone responsible for launching the Super Tuscan movement. The aristocratic Incisa della Rocchetta family has owned the land since the early 19th century, and the Marquis at the helm of the estate continues its grand tradition today.

The name Sassicaia means "place of many stones" and refers to the gravelly soil of the estate comparing to those found in the Médoc region in France. As a matter of fact, in the time pre-dating the Sixties no one had ever considered making a wine produced along Bordeaux lines on Italian soil, much less in a region which was not established viticulturally. It was the drive and foresight of the owner, along with the guidance of a world-famous winemaker, that made oenological history in what is now considered to be the birthplace of Tuscan Cabernet. Today, their signature wine Sassicaia is widely accepted as one of the world's greatest Cabernet Sauvignons, and its enormous success even prompted the Italian government to grant the wine its own appellation.

The magnificent coastal property in Bolgheri will take your breath away: it comes complete with a farm that raises world-class racehorses and a private nature reserve boasting acres of freshwater marsh, wet meadows, pastures, arable land and many species of wild animals which call this area home.

If you're a wine lover or collector, or if you simply want to deepen your knowledge of a legendary estate, then this wine experience is unmissable. The private tour will begin with a visit to the vineyards and the aging cellar, to end with an exclusive wine tasting of the winery's current vintages.
